

# Levocetirizine & Montelukast

### **Product Overview**

Product Name: MONKLEN-LC

### Active Ingredients:

- Levocetirizine Dihydrochloride IP: 5 mg

- Montelukast Sodium IP equivalent to Montelukast: 10 mg

Formulation: Oral Tablet

Pack Size: 10 Tablets per Strip / 10x10 Pack

### **Mechanism of Action**

Levocetirizine is a selective H1-receptor antagonist that reduces the effects of histamine, a natural chemical involved in allergic reactions.

Montelukast is a leukotriene receptor antagonist that blocks substances called leukotrienes, which cause allergy symptoms and inflammation.

#### Combined Action:

- Provides comprehensive control of allergic symptoms
- Reduces nasal congestion, sneezing, and wheezing
- Minimizes inflammation in allergic rhinitis and asthma

### **Indications**

Levocetirizine and Montelukast Tablet is indicated for the treatment of:

- Allergic Rhinitis (seasonal and perennial)
- Chronic Urticaria (hives)



- Asthma (as add-on therapy)
- Sneezing, runny nose, nasal congestion, and itchy eyes/nose

### **Dosage & Administration**

Recommended Dosage (Adults and children over 12 years):

- One tablet once daily in the evening or as prescribed by the physician.

### Administration:

- Can be taken with or without food.
- Swallow the tablet whole with water.

Note: Dosage in children under 12 should be adjusted by a physician based on weight and clinical condition.

### **Storage & Safety**

### Storage:

- Store in a cool, dry place, below 25°C.
- Protect from light and moisture.

#### Precautions:

- Avoid alcohol while taking this medication.
- Use with caution in patients with renal impairment or psychiatric disorders.
- Not recommended during pregnancy and lactation without medical advice.

### Side Effects May Include:

- Drowsiness
- Headache
- Dry mouth
- Abdominal discomfort
