Generic Name: Rabeprazole and Domperidone capsules

Strength: Rabeprazole 20 mg (EC) + Domperidone 30 mg (SR)

Dosage Form: capsules

### **COMPOSITION**

Each hard gelatin capsule contains:

Rabeprazole Sodium IP equivalent to Rabeprazole ... 20 mg (Enteric Coated)

Domperidone Maleate IP equivalent to Domperidone ... 30 mg (Sustained

Release) Excipients: q.s.

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#### **DESCRIPTION**

Rabeprazole is a proton pump inhibitor (PPI) that suppresses gastric acid secretion by inhibiting the H+/K+ ATPase enzyme in the stomach lining.

Domperidone is a prokinetic and antiemetic that enhances gastrointestinal motility and prevents nausea and vomiting.

This combination is effective in the treatment of acid-related gastrointestinal disorders and improves gastric emptying.

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#### **INDICATIONS**

Used in the treatment of:

- Gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD)
- Acid reflux and heartburn
- Functional dyspepsia
- Non-ulcer dyspepsia



- Nausea and vomiting related to acid peptic disorders
- Gastric and duodenal ulcers

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#### DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

Adults: One capsule daily, preferably 15–30 minutes before a meal, or as directed by the physician.

Do not chew or crush.

For best results, take at the same time each day.

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#### **CONTRAINDICATIONS**

- Known hypersensitivity to rabeprazole, domperidone, or any component of the formulation
  - Patients with prolactin-secreting tumors (prolactinoma)
  - Patients with gastrointestinal hemorrhage, mechanical obstruction, or perforation
- Domperidone is contraindicated in patients with moderate to severe hepatic impairment or prolonged QT interval

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# **PRECAUTIONS**

- Use with caution in patients with liver or kidney dysfunction
- Long-term use of rabeprazole may result in vitamin B12 deficiency,

hypomagnesemia, or osteoporosis-related fractures

- Domperidone may cause QT prolongation; monitor ECG and electrolytes in atrisk patients
  - Avoid concurrent use with other QT-prolonging medications

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#### SIDE EFFECTS

# Common:

- Headache
- Diarrhea or constipation
- Abdominal pain
- Dizziness
- Dry mouth

Rare:



- Hypersensitivity reactions (rash, itching)
- Elevated liver enzymes
- Galactorrhea, gynecomastia (due to domperidone)
- QT interval prolongation

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#### STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Store in a cool, dry place below 25°C. Protect from light and moisture. Keep out of reach of children.
